### GIRLS' FOOTBALL TOURNAMENT

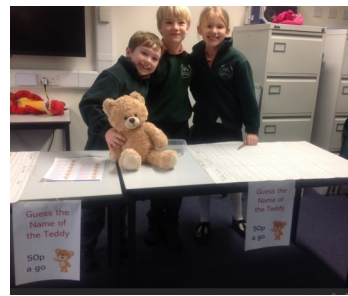
